The biggest reduction in crime is clearly the drop in thefts from motor vehicles from 18 to 5, burglary non dwelling from 8 to 6, dwelling burglary from 2 to 0 and other classifications which have impacted on the figures generally. The big drop is due to what is called a one-man crime wave, the individual has moved away.
